KEY WEST, FLORIDA Itinerary November 4 – Nov 12 - 2017

To save expenses, room sharing is an available option

Sat., Nov 4th – Loading bikes at Lynn's or bring them to me by this date. For the ones riding down with me in the truck, we will leave early Saturday afternoon after loading bikes. This will cut the trip in half. We will spend the night in St. George, SC. Others will either fly into Daytona on Sunday or drive and meet us at Destination Daytona Hotel.

Sun., Nov 5th – We will arrive in Daytona mid afternoon. Unload bikes upon arrival. We will have time for you to visit the largest Harley-Davidson dealership in the world ... Bruce Rossmeyer's Harley-Davidson to buy tee shirts or souvenirs. Reservations for tonight are at the Destination Daytona Hotel.

Mon., Nov 6th – Leave Daytona in the morning, riding the back roads, making our way towards Orlando, then heading South on Scenic Highway 441, which takes us around Lake Okeechobee towards Florida City, where we will overnight. Reservations for tonight are at the Ramada Inn.

Tues., Nov 7th – After breakfast, we will depart Florida City heading to the Everglades for a visit to an Alligator Farm and an airboat ride through Everglades National Park. After this exciting stop, we will continue on to Key West, making several stops at landmarks such as, Robbie's Marina and HOG Heaven for lunch. After lunch we will continue our ride to Key West making our way over approximately 43 bridges including the famous 7 mile bridge where the movie True Lies was filmed in 1994. Reservations for Key West are at the Best Western Ambassador which is located on the Atlantic side of the island. After checking in, we will venture downtown to experience the sunset at Mallory Square and roam around Duvall Street where you can shop, eat and visit such places as Hogs Breath Saloon, Sloppy Joes and Jimmy Buffet's.

Wed., Nov 8th – We will spend the day riding around Key West taking in all the sights, then ride to the famous “No Name Pub” in Long Pine Key for lunch, which was built in 1936. There are approximately 90,000+ one dollar bills hanging on the ceiling, walls and everywhere. Pretty interesting place plus the food is “excellent”. Hopefully, we will catch a glimpse of the Key Deer, which are endangered species list. Long Pine Key is the only place Key Deer exist in the world. World Championship Boat Races will be going on during our stay in Key West. We will be watching those Boat Races from Mallory Square. We will spend the night in Key West.

Thurs., Nov 9th – Another day to spend in Key West doing and going to places you have not visited or go back to visit your favorite place.

Fri., Nov. 10th – After breakfast, check out of Best Western Ambassador. We will head back to the mainland for our destination of Everglade City. Our ride today will be very exciting along Highway 41, where you will see plenty of alligators basking in the sun along the roadside. Reservations for Everglade City will be at the Captain’s Table Hotel.

Sat., Nov. 11th – After breakfast, check out of the hotel and we will continue North along the scenic byways through the orange groves on our way to Daytona. Late afternoon arrival back in Daytona with reservations again tonight at Destination Daytona. Load bikes at arrival in Daytona.

Sun., Nov. 12th – After breakfast, leave for home. Be home late afternoon.
