Panama City Bike Rally & New Orleans Tour Itinerary May 3rd – May 13th, 2017

Sunday, April 30th – Load Bikes at Lynn's, or if needed bring prior to this date.

What to Bring: All luggage, hang up clothes, helmets, boots, leathers, cameras, etc. Bring appropriate cool and warm weather clothing (riding gear), gloves, jackets, and rain gear. Also don't forget sun block and chapstick!

Bike registration must be with bike or a copy of it

To save on expenses, room sharing is an option.

If you don't want to do the Bike Rally in Panama City, you can opt to fly in or drive in on Thur. May 4th or Friday May 5th. We will leave Panama City on Sunday morning May 7th.

Mon. May 1st– I leave today heading to Panama City, FL. For the people that have the time, you can ride down in the truck with me. We will spend the night in Eufaula, AL at the Day's Inn.

Tues. May 2nd – We will arrive in Panama City, FL in the afternoon and park at the Red Roof Inn.

This is where the truck and trailer will be parked for the entire time. While we are in Panama City we will be staying at the Comfort Suites a couple of miles down the road.

Wed. May 3rd – When flying in you will get a taxi and come to the Red Roof Inn where the trailer is parked and pick up your motorcycle and luggage and I'll take you to the Comfort Suites. We can then head to the Rally (Thunder on the Beach).

Thurs. May 4th – We will hit the Rally Scene visiting many Vendors, sights, or go to the Beaches which are some of the prettiest in the country. We can even take a ride following the coastline East toward the Apalachicola National Forest. At night we will head down to visit all the nightlife of the Rally.

Fri. May 5th – Spend another day at the Rally or do another Day ride. You can explore all of the History of Panama City in the Historical District. Late afternoon take the things you don't need for the rest of the trip to New Orleans back to the trailer. Last night at the Rally so have fun!

Sat. May 6th – Our last day in Panama City Beach Rally so enjoy,

Sun. May 7th – After breakfast and checking out of the Comfort Suites we will head west along the coastline of Florida, through Fort Walton Beach and Gulf Breeze toward Pensacola We will have lunch at Lambert Café where the wait staff throws homemade rolls at you! We will end the day in Gulf Shores, AL

at the Best Western on the Beach. You can go explore Fort Morgan State Historical site or hang out on the Beach. We can eat dinner at one of the many Seafood Restaurants nearby.

Mon. May 8th – After breakfast and checking out of the Best Western, we will head toward fort Morgan where we will pick up the Ferry that will take us across Mobile Bay to Dolphin Island which will be a 7 mile ride. Oil Platforms will dot the Mobile Bay. We will take a break on the island. We will then head back to the mainland staying on the Gulf Shores into Mississippi going through Biloxi and Gulfport with white sand beaches for miles. We will stay on the old road until we arrive in New Orleans. We will be staying at the LaQuinta Inn for 5 nights. We can then take a taxi downtown to the French quarters. While in New Orleans you can do your own thing, or hang out with the group.

Tues. May 9th – After breakfast we will head down to the French Quarters for a day of fun. There is so much to do and see here. You can do the walking tours, Ghost tours, and shopping. On Bourbon Street you have some of the best restaurants in the World, with plenty of Blues and Jazz Bars. Also La Quinta has laundry facilities if you need to do some laundry.

Wed. May 10th – We will do a day ride to Grand Isle which is on the Gulf of Mexico. We will ride along one of the waterways where the Shrimp Boats come in from their day's catch from the Gulf. We will have lunch in Grand Isle before heading back to the hotel. If we're not wore out, we'll head back down to the French Quarters!

Thur. May 11th – You can do your own thing or you can do a ride with us to Houma, LA and Bayou Lane. This is where the swamp people is filmed with the Alligator Hunters as seen on the A & E Channel. We will ride back roads of Southern LA before heading back to the hotel. After the ride we can take a taxi back to the French Quarters for the last night in New Orleans.

Fri. May 12th – When we leave New Orleans on our way back to Panama City, we will first ride the 29 mile bridge across Lake Pontchartrain on our way to Northshore HD in Slidell, LA. We then hit the interstate back to Panama City where we will be staying at the Red Roof Inn. We will load motorcycles late that afternoon.

Sat. May 13th – I will be leaving heading home and the rest will take a taxi to the Airport for the flight home.
