Rocky Mountain Tour – Colorado and Utah Itinerary June 16 - 25, 2017

Saturday – June 10th – Load Bikes at Lynn’s or bring prior to this date.

Suggested items to pack with your bike include the following:

All luggage, hang up clothes, helmets, boots, leathers, cameras, etc. Bring appropriate cold and warm weather clothing (riding gear), chaps, gloves, jackets, and rain gear. During this time of year, it is necessary to layer your clothes because it will be cold in the morning and will warm up during the day. Also don't forget sun block and chapstick!

Due to Hazardous Materials restrictions **-please DO NOT fill gas tank. Additionally, bike registration must be available along with personal contact information -Your Cell phone and an Emergency Contact number.**

To save expenses, room sharing is an available option

Friday – June 16th -Fly into Denver, Colorado. The hotel, Quality Inn and Suites offers a free airport shuttle for your convenience; give them a call upon arrival. The hotel is located about 5 minutes from the airport and next door to Mile High Harley Davidson.

Saturday – June 17th – Today we will take an unbelievable ride to Estes Park and Rocky Mountain National Park (this is where the Colorado River begins). We will cross over snow-covered peaks in excess of 10,000 to 12,000 feet! Sites will include of herds of Elk and Mountain Goats as well as clear mountain lakes. We will return to Denver to the Quality Inn for the night.

Sunday – June 18th – Depart Denver for a ride to Salida, Colorado; where we will stay overnight at the Comfort Inn, in Salida, CO. Today’s touring will primarily be on scenic highways through Canyons and along rivers.

Monday – June 19th – Depart Salida in route to South Fork, CO. where we will overnight at the Wolf Creek Ski Lodge. Along the way, we will visit Salida, Gunnison, and Lake City, National Forest also is the headwaters of the Rio Grande River and has the moonscape wonder of the Wheeler Geologic Area, established by Theodore Roosevelt in 1911. We will also go through Echo Canyon and several National Forest. This is an awesome day of riding but also the longest day of riding.

Rocky Mountain Tour (continued)

Tuesday – June 20th – Depart South Fork in route to Durango, CO; where we will overnight at Ramada Inn. Today we will ride across Wolf Creek Pass, elevation of 11,000 feet, visit Mesa Verde National Park, which protects over 4,000 known Archeological Sites, including 600 Cliff Dwellings. This evening we will take a stroll back in time walking the streets of downtown Durango.

Wednesday – June 21st – Depart Durango in route to Moab, Utah where we will stay at the Ramada Inn. We will be riding along the river and the Silverton Narrow Gorge Railroad Tracks. This road is called the Million Dollar Highway. For lunch, we will stop in Telluride, a well known Ski Resort. Today's ride consists of all scenic highways.

Thursday – June 22nd – After breakfast, we will head toward Arches National Park and Canyonland National Park to tour. From there our ride takes us on scenic highways through Canyons, Redrock Cliffs, with the Colorado River flowing beside us. We will enjoy Lunch today at a Winery along side the Colorado River. We then make our way to Grand Junction, Colorado and visit the Harley-Davidson Dealership. Tonight we will stay in Delta, CO. at the Days Inn.

Friday – June 23rd – Depart Delta in route to Leadville, CO. (Old Mining Town) where we will overnight at the Silver King Inn. Today's ride will again be on scenic highways with stops at Snowmass and Aspen, well known Ski Resorts. We will cross over Independence Pass, called "The Top of the Rockies" which has some of Colorado's finest Alpine Views located on the Continental Divide at an elevation of 12, 095 feet. From Montrose to Leadville we will ride through several National Forest.

Saturday – June 24th – Depart Leadville in route to Denver for the last night of the tour, with accommodations being at the Quality Inn and Suites. Today's ride takes us through Breckenridge, Vail, and several old Mining Towns and passes over 10,000 feet and again through several National Forest...all scenic highways. Once back in Denver, we will load Bikes late Saturday afternoon.

Sunday – June 25th – Fly home. The Hotel shuttle will take you back to the Airport. This tour is an UNBELIEVABLE ride with lots of Scenic Highways and Awesome Views. You will not be disappointed.

Approximately 1800 riding miles
