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## **Jackson Hole, Wyoming Tour Itinerary July 7 - 16, 2017**

**Saturday-July 1st or before** – Load bikes at Lynn Isenhour's residence

**Suggested items to pack with your bike include the following:**

All luggage, hang up clothes, helmets, boots, leathers, cameras, etc. Bring appropriate cold and warm weather clothing (riding gear), chaps, gloves, jackets, and rain gear. During this time of year, it is necessary to layer your clothes because it will be cold in the morning and will warm up during the day. Also don't forget sun block and chapstick!

Due to Hazardous Materials restrictions -**please DO NOT fill gas tank. Additionally, bike registration must be available along with personal contact information -Your Cell phone and an Emergency Contact number.**

**To save expenses, room sharing is an available option**

**NOTE:** Entrance Fees into Teton and Yellowstone National Park is \$20.00 per park, and is good for 7 days. Keep it handy as you will need it each time you enter the park.

**Friday -July 7th** -Fly into Jackson Hole. JAC is the airport code. Early arrival is best! Preplan to take the airport shuttle to Teton Village or Lynn will pick up. This will be decided once all airline reservations are confirmed and arrival time determined. After check in, explore Teton Village, enjoy lunch at the Mangy Moose, then either prepare to take a short ride or be at your leisure -there is a lot to do around Teton Village or downtown Jackson Hole.

**Saturday -July 8th** -Today's ride takes us to Teton National Park where we will see Jenny Lake with its Beautiful Crystal Clear Waters, pay a visit to the most photographed Barn with the Teton Mountains as its backdrop and Signal Mountain -(Lynn's favorite place) with an awesome view of the Snake River and the valley below. During today you will possibly see Moose, Elk, Buffalo and Bear. We complete our day downtown Jackson Hole where there are lots of shops, great places to eat, relax at the Million Dollar Cowboy Bar and see the excitement of a great Western Town.

**Sunday -July 9th** -Today's ride is full of sites! Starting with Yellowstone National Park where we will see Old Faithful, ride through Fire Hole Canyon, see active Geysers, and Scenic Highways as we make our way to Idaho where you will be amazed at the beauty of the potato fields, sunflowers and alfalfa hay fields -with the backdrop being the back side of the Tetons. Be on the lookout for Elk, Antelope, Buffalo, and possibly a Bald Eagle.

**Monday -July 10th** -Today's ride we will cross Teton Pass making our way back into Idaho to Swan Valley with a short stop at Rainey Creek -home of the world famous "Square Ice Cream". We will then follow the winding Snake River (watch for white water rafters) making our way through Hoback Canyon where we will eat lunch in Bondurant, Wyoming at the Branding Iron Cafe. Once back at the Village, pack your bike for the 4 day/3 night trip to Cody, WY and Gardiner, MT.

## **Jackson Hole Tour (Continued)**

**Tuesday – July 11th** – Early departure heading to Cody Wyoming. This is an awesome ride as the terrain will change. Keep your National Park pass handy as we will enter Yellowstone National Park and go to the famous Yellowstone Hotel on Yellowstone Lake. After we cross the mountain, we will stop for lunch at the Wapita Lodge, the hunting Lodge of Buffalo Bill, and where the Queen of England visited. Be on the lookout for grizzly bears as they are often seen around the lodge. Then we will continue on to Cody where we will be staying at the Buffalo Bill Resort in a Western Style Cabin. After settling in to your cabin, you can explore the Town of Cody.

**Wednesday – July 12th** – Spend the day in Cody visiting the Museums and shopping or we will do a day ride across Big Horn Mountain Range which is an unbelievable ride. Tonight we will go to the Rodeo.

**Thursday – July 13th** – Eat breakfast at Historic Erma's Hotel. The ride just keeps getting better as we start out on Chief Joseph Highway and across Bear Tooth Pass which is said to be the most Scenic Highway in the Country. After lunch in Red Lodge, Montana, we will ride through Cook City, then Yellowstone National Park through Lamar Valley where we will see herds of Buffalo, and possibly Wolves and Bear, continuing through Mammoth Hot Springs where you will see herds of Elk grazing on the lawn. The day ends in Gardiner, Montana with accommodations at the Absaroka Lodge on the Snake River.

**Friday – July 14th** – After breakfast we leave Gardiner to go explore Mammoth Hot Springs. You will see up close the Thermal Pools of the Hot Springs. As we make our way back to Teton Village we will visit Artist Point, an Awesome Waterfall – it has the "Wow" Factor! Also we will make several stops at Opal Pools, see a Mud Volcano, and visit West Thumb Basin. Today you will see Buffalo and Elk. We will have an early dinner at Dorman's, a Western Style chuck wagon dinner. Tonight we will be back at the Teton Village – Hostel.

**Saturday – July 15th** – At your leisure. Visit Jackson Hole, ride the Tram up the Mountain, or take a 4 to 5 hour ride. Be prepared to load bikes and luggage this afternoon. This day you will be depressed, as you realize the fun is over. Tonight we will have a Pizza Party and look back at all the fun we had this past week.

**Sunday – July 16th** – Fly home. Shuttle or taxi will take you to the airport with pick up time about 2 hours prior to departure.

Approximately 1500 riding miles

**Fee:** \$1,400.00 Per Bike. No Extra Charge for Passenger. (Fuel surcharge may apply).

Motel – 10 days & 9 nights approximately \$1150.00 plus tax. A small deposit for the rooms will be required.

\*\*If you desire a different motel while at the Teton Village other than the Hostel that can be arranged at a higher cost. The Hostel is a plain place, but cheap.
