New England Fall Tour Itinerary September 15 - 24, 2017

Saturday, Sept. 9th- Load bikes at Lynn's or bring prior to the date.

Suggested items to pack with your bike include the following:

All luggage, hang up clothes, helmets, boots, leathers, cameras, etc. Bring appropriate cold and warm weather clothing (riding gear), chaps, gloves, jackets, and rain gear. Also don't forget sun block and chap stick!

Due to Hazardous Materials restrictions -**please DO NOT fill gas tank. Additionally, bike registration must be available along with personal contact information -Your Cell phone and an Emergency Contact number.**

To save expenses, room sharing is an available option

Friday, Sept. 15th – Fly into Albany, NY. There is a FREE shuttle to the Best Western Airport where we will be staying. After everyone checks in, we will do a short ride to Spitzies's H-D. Then we pack our bikes for our 8 day tour.

Saturday, Sept. 16th – After breakfast & checking out of the Best Western, we will head North. Our first stop will be in the Picturesque Vacation Town of Lake George, NY. We will then travel Scenic Highways in the Adirondacks Mt. Range heading to Lake Placid where the Winter Olympics were held. We will have time to explore this quaint little town. We will spend the night at the Northwood Inns.

Sunday, Sept. 17th – After leaving Lake Placid we will ride some beautiful back roads stopping at several waterfalls & crossing Whiteface Mt. Range. We will travel through the small town of North Pole & Santa's Workshop. We will then head North along Lake Champlain. We will stop in Plattsburgh, NY for lunch & a visit to North End H-D. We will then head North to the Canadian Border before turning East & crossing Lake Champlain into Vermont heading to Burlington, VT. With a stop at Green Mountain H-D. we will end the day at the Quality Inn in Colchester, VT.

Monday, Sept 18th– After breakfast we will head South with our first stop in Shelburne, VT. where we will take a tour of Shelburne Farms. This is a working Farm built in 1886. We will then ride to Middleburg, VT. for lunch at Fire And Ice, which has been featured in Magazines & on the Food Network. We will then hit the back roads with stops at Waterfalls & Covered Bridges. We will stop in Waterbury, VT. & Tour the Ice Cream Factory of Ben & Jerry's. We will end this day in Morrisville, VT. staying at the Commodores Inn.

New England Fall Tour (Cont'd)

Tuesday, Sept. 19th – After breakfast next door at Sam's Charlmont Restaurant. We will ride Scenic Highways heading North through Newport, VT. watching out for Moose crossing the road. Lunch will be in Island Pond at one of the local hangouts. We will then cross the state of New Hampshire & then into Maine. We will end this day in Farmington, Maine, staying at the Comfort Inn.

Wednesday, Sept. 20th – After breakfast at Crossroad Diner we will hit the road with a stop at Rumford Falls for some pictures. Lunch will be in Newport, Maine. We will stop at Central Maine H-D for Souvenirs'. We will get to Bar Harbor, Maine early afternoon. This is an Amazing CoastlineTown with plenty of things to do & see with plenty of Restaurants where we can eat Great Seafood. We will spend the night here in Bar Harbor at the Bar Harbor Villager Motel which is downtown.

Thursday, Sept. 21st – When leaving Bar Harbor we will tour Aracadia National Park which has a lot of Fantastic Views of the Coastline. We will then head South along the Coastline stopping at several Harbor Towns along the way. We will stop in Freeport, Maine at the LL Bean Store which is HUGE. There you can do some shopping. Then we will head to Portland, Maine where we will spend the night at the Howard Johnson.

Friday, Sept. 22nd – After leaving Fireside Inn we will visit Moose H-D. We will then travel the Scenic Highways of Maine heading West crossing back into New Hampshire with stops at an Old Covered Bridge built in the early 1800's. Our next stop will be in Meredith, New Hampshire at Lake Winnepesaukee. We will stop at Laconia H-D & eat lunch next door at Turkey Farm Restaurant & then ride through Laconia, NH. where they have the Laconia Bike Rally in June every year. We will end this day in Springfield, VT., at the Holiday Inn Express.

Saturday, Sept. 23rd – After breakfast at the Little Diner Inn we will hit more of the New England Scenic Highways crossing the Connecticut River back into Vermont. We will ride through the Green Mt. National Forest. Lunch will be in Bennington, VT. before re-entering the State of New York on our way back to Albany, NY. We will check back into the Best Western Airport. We will load bikes & luggage later afternoon.

Sunday, Sept. 24th – Fly home – free shuttle to airport.
